




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Never swim alone – always swim with a friend!




It's easy to trip and hurt yourself around the pool. Avoid slips and falls: **Never Run Around the Pool!**


...but inflatable pool toys and water wings are no substitute! No matter if you're at the beach, or out on a boat – you should always make sure to wear a life jacket.

Circle the correct life-saving devices. Cross out the pool toys.







It's hot out there during the summer! Be sure to drink plenty of water and apply sunblock to protect yourself from the sun.






If you get in trouble in the pool, a lifeguard can save you.

What can know

- Go over this book with your child. Do the activities together. Explain everything clearly so that they understand the importance of water safety.
- Supervise children whenever they are around the water even if a lifeguard is present. NEVER drop your kids off at the public pool or leave them at the beach always have a responsible adult present to supervise.
- Stay within arm's reach of young children. Avoid distractions when supervising children near the water.
- Install barriers and safety covers around home pools or hot tubs. Pool alarms are an option for additional protection.
- For above-ground or inflatable pools, remove access ladders and secure the safety cover when the pool is not in use.
- Remove any structures that provide access to the pool, such as outdoor furniture, climbable trees, or playground equipment.
- Place pool toys that are not in use away from the pool. Toys can attract young children to the pool area.

Basic water safety practices will help everyone have fun in the sun this summer!
