

# HOME FIRES

result in nearly  
**\$9,000,000,000**  
in losses.

# SMOKING MATERIALS

(falling asleep with a  
lit cigarette, etc.) were  
the leading cause of  
**fire deaths** overall.

People between  
the ages of

**25-34**

account for the largest  
number of home fire  
injuries, over **15%**.

People between  
the ages of

**55-64**

account for the largest  
number of home fire  
deaths, over **20%**.

# MALES

are more likely to be  
killed or injured in home  
fires and accounted for a  
larger percentage of the  
victims, **57% of death**  
and **55% of injuries**.

# CHILDREN

under 15 account for  
**11%** of the home fire  
fatalities and **9%** of  
the injuries.

# HOME FIRES

are responsible for  
**about 75%** of all fire  
deaths and **72%** of  
all fire injuries

# HOME FIRES

lead to **more than 2,800**  
people dying and **more**  
**than 11,000** injuries  
each year.
